Venue

Brussels formally the Brussels-Capital Region is a locale of Belgium containing 19 regions, including the City of Brussels, which is the capital of Belgium. As the focal point of European culture and organizations, Brussels has significantly more to offer than a great most people envision. Brussels is the most densely populated and the most extravagant area in Belgium as far as GDP per capita. It is additionally part of a huge conurbation extending out towards Ghent, Antwerp, Leuven and Walloon Brabant, home to more than 5 million individuals. Touring Brussels is best amid the day so at evening you can appreciate creative and atmospheric restaurants and bars. Citizens of the European Union Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein can travel to Belgium on the basis of their national ID card or passport. They do not need a visa to travel to Belgium.
