ABOUT JEJU ISLAND

Jeju Island is the only self-governing province in South Korea, meaning that the province is run by local natives instead of that from the mainland. The island of Jeju was, form by the interruption of an underwater volcano approximately 2 million years ago. and is home to pristine nature and exquisite beaches.

The island is home to 660,000 people but hosts 15,000,000 visitors per year. English is not widely spoken in Jeju and as a matter fact, the local dialect is different enough from Korean that it is recognized as a distinct language. Until recently, Chinese travelers accounted for 80% of foreign travelers, Though in the past year 2017 tourism has declined sharply, visits to Jeju continue to be a vacation destination for Asia

Residents and tourists alike love the nature of the Island. It has three UNESCO World Heritage sites, is packed with museums and theme parks and also has horses, mountains, lava tube caves, and waterfalls with clear blue ocean lapping its beaches. The Haenyeo (Jeju female divers) harvest oysters, abalone, clams, seaweed and other marine life and their history are showcased at the island's Haenyeo museum.
