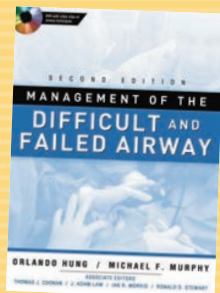

Fiberoptic Lung Separation Workshop (Optional)

In this pre-course workshop, participants learn and practice lung separation techniques in airway simulators. The Workshop focuses on left and right double lumen tube placement with confirmation of placement and troubleshooting.
