Course Description

The 3rd Annual MUSC Craniofacial and Cleft Anomalies Conference is a one-day course designed for practitioners of all disciplines who are involved in the care of patients with craniofacial anomalies and cleft lip/palate; and who want to supplement his/her knowledge and skills pertaining to the diagnosis, management, and treatment of this type of patient. The course will cover several key topics in the management of children with cleft lip/palate and other craniofacial conditions. Our objective is to provide the attendees with up-to-date knowledge in this field that will enable them to employ best current practices when treating these children.

Objectives

Upon completion of this course participants should be able to:

- Name factors that differentiate syndromic vs. nonsyndromic etiologies in infants with cleft lip and palate.
- Explain the basic anatomy and physiology of the velopharyngeal system, and specifically what accounts for the failure of that system to work normally.
- Describe the effects of inadequate velopharyngeal closure on early speech development and language acquisition.
- Discuss the role of the community speech-language pathologist as a valuable extension of the craniofacial anomalies team.
- State the importance of voice-onset in the treatment of children with difficult phoneme replacement speech behaviors including those that are compensatory in nature.

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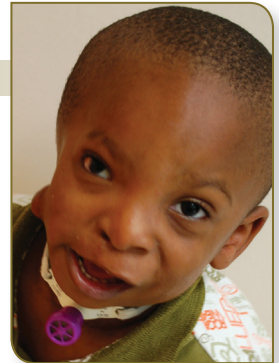
