## CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

Our **20<sup>th</sup> Annual Summer Conference on Obstetrics and Gynecology** has been designed for physicians, certified nurse midwives, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses and other health care professionals who face ever-increasing challenges in the clinical diagnoses, treatment options, and new technologies involved in caring for the female patient. The goal of this conference is to present current clinical data on key issues in obstetrics and gynecology, along with treatment options to manage these challenges. Emphasis will be placed on practical application of the evidence-based topics presented. In addition to didactic lectures and smaller group breakouts, ample time has been allotted for participant feedback and interaction.
