CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

Our **15th Annual Summer Conference on Pediatrics** is designed to provide physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants and nurses involved in the care of the pediatric patient with up-to-date and evidence-based clinical data in Pediatrics.
