GENERAL INFORMATION

Program Overview: As part of our commitment to training in primary care, the UMass Medical School Office of Continuing Medical Education offers this program to provide updates on a wide range of rapidly changing Primary Care topics. The program will feature concurrent presentations from which attendees can select his/her own learning track. Faculty may use didactic and case presentations. Each session will be facilitated by a primary care physician.

Target Audience: Physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses and residents in primary care.

Educational Objectives: *At the conclusion of the program, the participant should understand:*

- The most up-to-date recommendations concerning the care of patients with diabetes mellitus, hypertension, BPH, congestive heart failure, ADD and other common clinical encounters in the primary care setting.
- Ways to improve patient safety when prescribing opioids.
- Ongoing discussions concerning healthcare reform.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Fees: An Early Bird Registration fee will apply to all two-day attendees when registering by 3/1/13. Physicians: early bird (prior to 3/1/13) \$285 for both days; (after 3/1/13) \$310 for both days and \$185 for one day.

Nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and all others registration fees: early bird (prior to 3/1/13) \$190 for both days; (after 3/1/13) \$215 for both days and \$140 for one day.

Residents: \$100 for both days and \$75 for one day.

On-site Registration: On-site registration will be available (space permitting) and will be assessed an additional \$25 to the published registration fee. Above fees include course materials, continental breakfasts, luncheons, and continuing education credit.

Deadline: Pre-registration will be closed when space is full or on April 1, 2013 at the latest. Registration should not be mailed unless receipt before that time is guaranteed.
