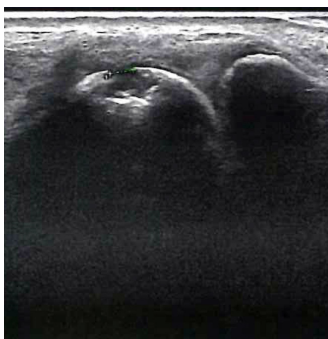

Clinical Applications of Musculoskeletal Ultrasound

This two-day intensive workshop at our new state-of-the-art Clinical Skills Education and Assessment Center teaches the fundamentals of musculoskeletal ultrasound of the extremities. The introductory track is ideal for rheumatologists new to ultrasound while the intermediate track will provide an excellent opportunity to hone skills for participants with more experience. Leaders in the field of musculoskeletal ultrasonography will review ultrasound scanning techniques, normal extremity anatomy and common pathology as seen on ultrasound.
