COURSE DESCRIPTION

This four-day intensive, comprehensive review will incorporate data supporting guideline-based recommendations and recent advances regarding the management of patients with malignant hematologic and solid tumor disorders. Attendees will have the opportunity to participate in case-based review sessions and discussions and will have access to a comprehensive syllabus and self-assessment materials.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Describe the pathogenesis, diagnostic evaluation, and therapeutic modalities available for common malignant hematological diseases
- Describe the pathogenesis, diagnostic evaluation, and therapeutic modalities available for common solid tumor malignancies
- Integrate guideline-based treatments into personalized clinical practice appropriate for patients
- Integrate new therapeutic and diagnostic approaches into clinical practice as appropriate

This course is designed for physicians who are preparing for the medical oncology certification or re-certification exam as well as physicians and allied health professionals who desire an update in current standards of care for patients with cancer.
