Rental Car

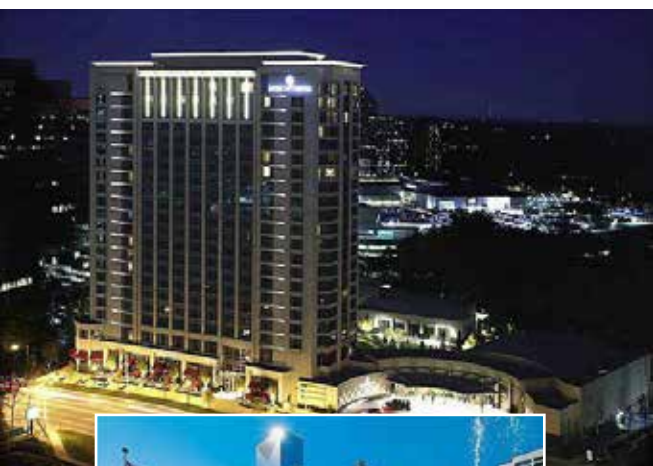
