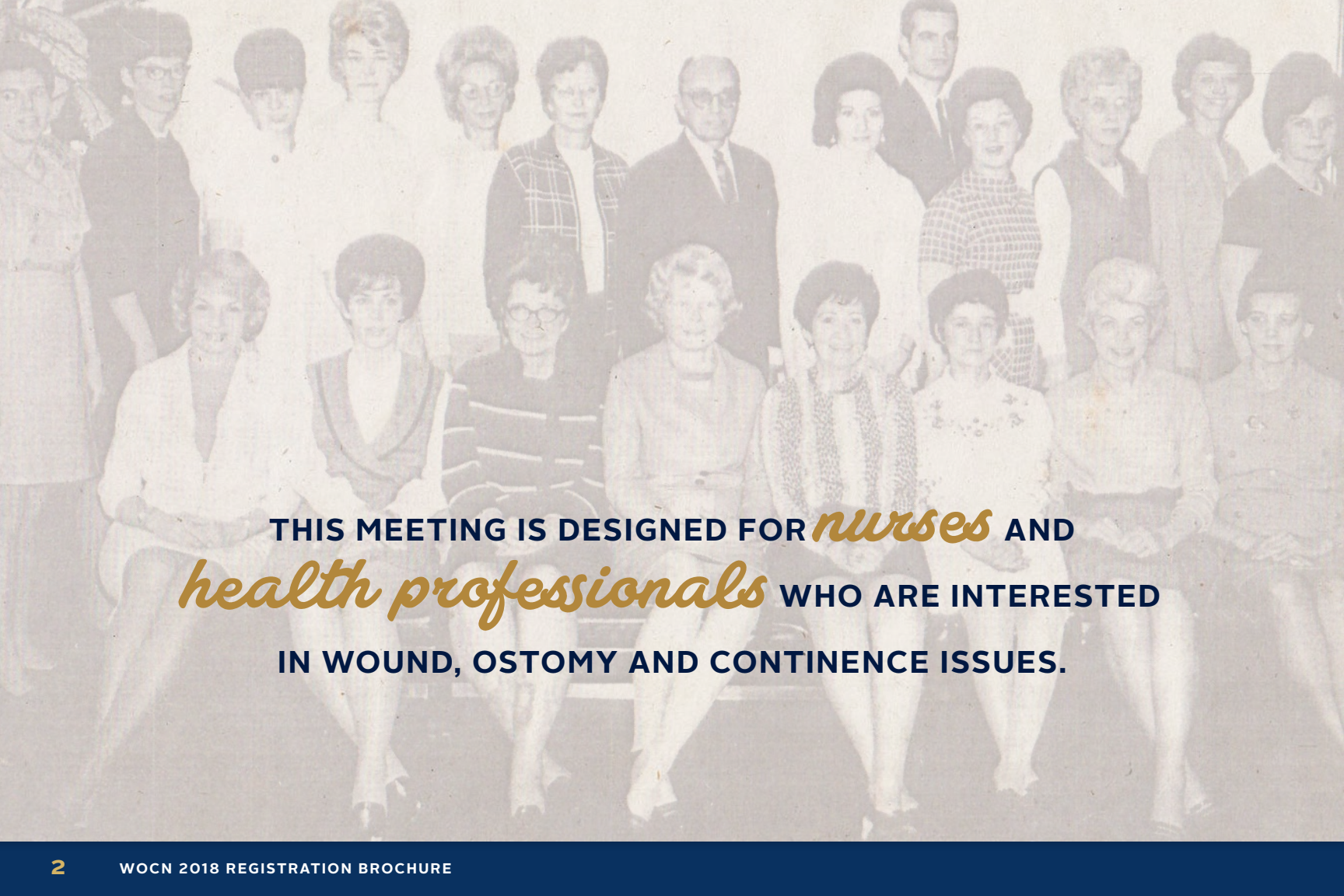

— Goals —

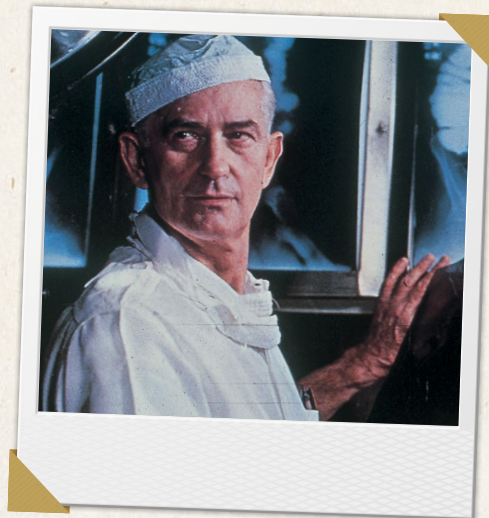
