COURSE DESCRIPTION

The one day Sickle Cell Disease conference will feature educational sessions for healthcare providers, patients/families, and social services providers. The morning sessions will be devoted to healthcare providers and the afternoon sessions will be tailored for patients, family members and social workers. Medically oriented topics will include medical complications, pediatric care, emergency room protocol and others. Patient oriented topics will include an “Ask the Doctor” session in which patients can get direct answers from Sickle Cell specialists. Other afternoon topics will provide tips for self-advocacy in the hospital and Sickle Cell Trait. All attendees will be provided with information about available resources and current trends in the field.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Identify and utilize recommended treatment protocols for Sickle Cell Disease (SCD) patients in the Emergency Department;
- Recognize the benefits of hydroxyurea treatment in SCD patients;
- Describe and apply best practices for transitioning SCD youth to adult care; and
- Apply best practices for treating children with SCD.

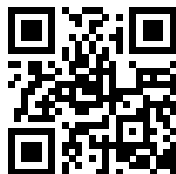
