Formerly an Assistant Professor of OB/GYN at Northwestern University Medical School, Lisa is a renowned expert

in fetal monitoring and perinatal safety. Lisa teaches multi-disciplinary fetal monitoring programs, and provides risk management/patient safety consultation to individuals, hospitals and other organizations. Lisa joined Drs. Along with coauthor Dr. David Miller, Lisa has provided "Train the Trainer" sessions for a joint initiative between ACOG District II and the Healthcare Association of New York State, with physician, midwife, and nursing participants from over 90 hospitals.

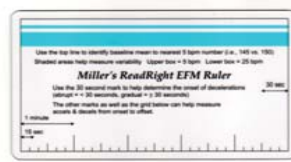
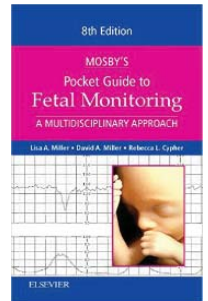

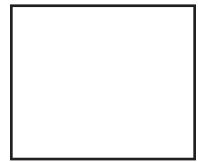
