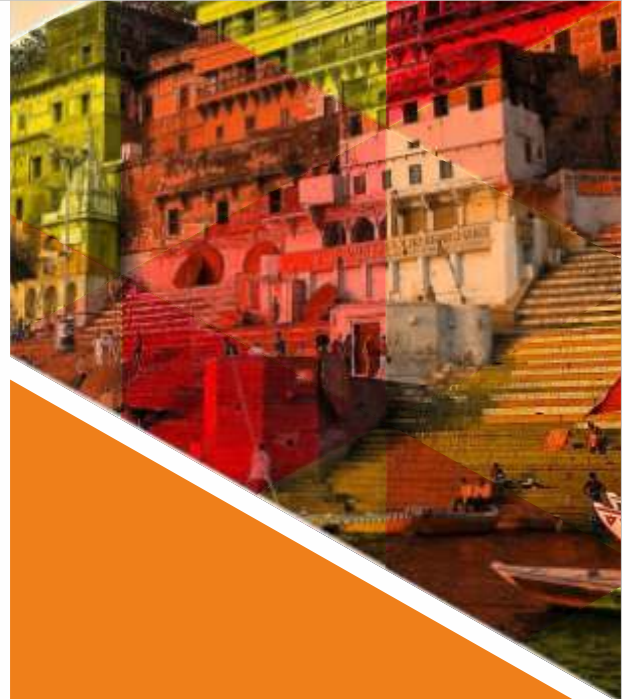

IAPP Awards

The Awards Committee of IAPP, under the Chairmanship of Dr. M.S. Reddy, invites papers for various awards listed below for presentation at ANCIAPP 2022, being held at Varanasi from 24th – 27th November 2022.

The details of awards for #ANCIAPP2022 are enumerated below:

● **Dr. Indla Rama Subba Reddy - IAPP Award**

For original work done by an IAPP Member Psychiatrist in any field of Psychiatry.

● **Samvedana Women's Award**

For work done or experienced in Psychiatry by a Woman IAPP member by a Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Social Worker or other related mental health professional.

● **Dr. Amit Bohra Oration Award**

This award has been instituted in memory of Dr. Amit Bohra by Dr. N.K. Bohra & Mrs. Neena Bohra. This oration will be delivered at each annual conference of IAPP by a senior life fellow of the society.

Rules & Regulations

Any life fellow can nominate a senior life fellow of the society who has more than ten years standing in the profession. The nomination should be accompanied with six copies of the bio-data of the nominee as well a written and signed consent of the nominee. This should be submitted to the chairperson Awards Committee by the date decided by the President and Secretary of the IAPP

The speaker can choose any subject of his choice which is of national importance and send the paper well in advance to the chairperson awards committee. No person shall win the award more than once

● **Dr. Anil Kumar Dutt - IAPP Award**

For best poster presentation by an IAPP member and open to all members of IAPP

● **ANCIAPP Varanasi - IAPP Award**

For the best original work done in any field of mental health by an IAPP member from any State Branch. The competing paper has to be sent through the State Branch of IAPP, which may select and forward only one paper from its State or send the best paper presented at the State Conference. IAPP members of states where State branches have not been formed as yet, may send directly.

● **Best Case Conference - Certificate of Excellence IAPP Award**

For the best clinical presentation of a case (Case Conference model without an actual patient) Video presentation of the interview is welcome. Open to all members of IAPP.

Submission of award paper -
15th September 2022



Guidelines for Submission

- 1) The paper once accepted for presentation at the conference will become the property of the IAPP for publication in its journal and can't be published anywhere else without the prior permission of the IAPP.
- 2) It has been further decided to give preference to the papers based on clinical work by giving weightage (by assigning marks set aside for this purpose) over papers presenting purely laboratory work or work on animals.
- 3) The award committee will also give extra marks for a paper if it comes from a person in practice in a remote area (village/district etc.) rather than from a metropolitan city.
- 4) Presentation of work from certain regions (like those from North - East, or where there is a dearth of Psychiatrists, lack of training & other sophisticated facilities) will also be given extra marks.
- 5) Certificate of Merit will be awarded to the best paper belonging to any of the above categories if they somehow miss the award despite the extra marks/weightage. (In case the proposed award paper meets any of the special criteria, please mention the criteria on a separate facet sheet).
- 6) The authors must mention his/her IAPP membership number and category at the time of applying for the award.

A full manuscript of the original work is to be sent via email to Dr. M.S. Reddy (drmsreddy@gmail.com) Co-chairperson, Awards Committee, and Dr. Avinash De Sousa (avinashdes888@gmail.com) Hon'y Secretary-General. The covering letter must mention to which award the paper is being sent and include the IAPP membership number, postal address, e-mail id and contact number of the person submitting the paper.

Call for Participation

Submission of Symposia Proposals

- Symposia are chosen on a highly competitive basis by the committee from proposals submitted online via conference website www.anciapp.com.
- The proposal submission should include a written commitment from each speaker to lecture at the ANCIAPP Varanasi conference. The proposal should also include a recent scientific reference for each speaker.
- Chairpersons can submit no more than two symposia proposals and speakers can agree to participate in no more than two proposals. All proposals will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and notifications to all symposia submitters will be sent out by 15 October 2022.
- The Chairman or proposer must submit a 500-word abstract that describes the symposium and the role of each speaker. The Chair should also provide a recent reference for each speaker and confirmation in writing that they are willing to present during the 23rd Annual National Conference of Indian Association of Private Psychiatry in Varanasi under the conditions stipulated. For each speaker, the title of the presentation should be listed in the proposal.

Attractions

Ghats running along River Ganges

A visit to Varanasi cannot be complete without a visit to the ghats running along River Ganges. There are about 88 ghats in the city. The evening arti (a religious ritual with lamps) at the ghats, primarily at Dashashwamedh, is a sight to behold. One of the more visually spectacular ghats is the Lalita Ghat.

Kashi Vishwanath Temple

One of the oldest, richest, and holiest shrines of India is located in the sacred city of Varanasi and is known as Shri Kashi Vishwanath Temple.





Sarnath

Believed to be the first place Gautum Buddha went after gaining enlightenment to preach his teachings on Dharma, is this small, quiet, peaceful town.

The Banaras Hindu University (BHU)

The Banaras Hindu University (BHU) is one of the oldest varsities in India. It was founded by renowned social reformer and freedom fighter Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya, in 1916, with the assistance of British socialist Dr Annie Besant. The sprawling 1,300-acre main university campus located on the outskirts of Varanasi was built on land donated by the ruler of Kashi



Manikarnika Ghat

One of the most auspicious and sacred ghats of the Hindus, Manikarnika is a significant ground for cremation. It is located between Dashashwamedh Ghat and Scindia Ghat.
