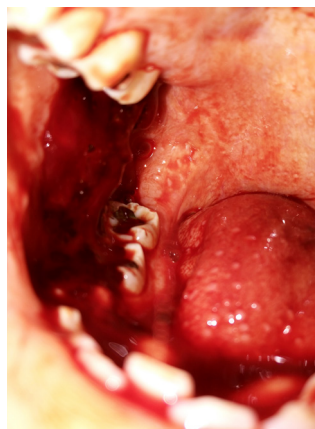


MOUTH CANCER CONFERENCE
