- To review human anatomy relevant to the insertion of PD catheters
- To learn the bedside unguided and US-guided PD catheter insertion techniques
- To gain hands-on experience performing insertions in a high-fidelity simulation environment

and nurses interested in setting up a non-surgical
PD catheter insertion program.

The maximum number of participants will be limited to
eight (8) physicians and four (4) nurses.

Nursing Objectives

- To learn how to set-up sterile environment and
instruments for a PD catheter insertion
- To learn how to assist physicians during and
insertion
