# OVERVIEW

- Develop appropriate management of Achalasia: the surgical vs. non surgical approaches
- Recognize the critical elements of pancreato-biliary endoscopy, including the technical aspects of procedures as well as appraise practical tips for technical success from endoscopy experts to integrate practice guidelines and expert opinion in the management of pancreatic cysts
- Implement established and emerging therapeutic techniques and technologies to improve the performance of EUS
- Recognize and ascertain the different endoscopic bariatric techniques as well as the potential advantages of reduced invasiveness, reversibility and the cost effectiveness over the more invasive/surgical approaches
- Compare the endoscopic vs. surgical techniques for the management of obesity
- Analyze the outcomes of bariatric endoscopy by understanding established and emerging therapeutic techniques and technologies
