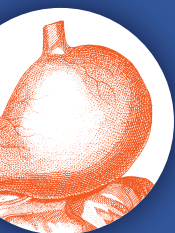
Dear endosonographer and EUS-nurse,

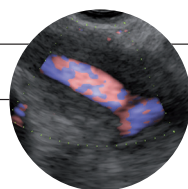

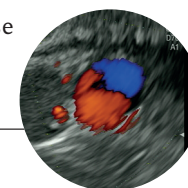
