



PAN EUROPE ASIA MEDICAL & LEGAL CONFERENCE

ST MORITZ, SWITZERLAND

18 - 25 JANUARY 2016



This conference coincides with CPE's Cortina d'Ampezzo Ski Conference to be held 10 - 17 January 2016. The multiple registration rate applies if you register simultaneously for both conferences.

St Moritz was the first and arguably remains the best all-round winter sports resort in the world, boasting a myriad of on and off-snow activities and networking opportunities. Its eponymous frozen lake is the setting each winter for skating, curling, golf, snow polo, horse racing, show jumping, and even cricket. The resort's bob run is the last remaining natural course in the world.

The resort is the world capital of winter glitz but there's more to the resort than bling. St Moritz's position at 1,856m in the Engadin Valley in the south of Switzerland, close to the frontier with Italy, gives it a rare combination of snow reliability and 300 sunshine days each year. Plus, its ski area is excellent, especially for intermediates. It has 58 lifts and 350km of pistes and is divided into four separate sectors. The bottom lift is at 1,800m and the top of the ski area at 3,305m.

The resort itself has a rather complex geography. It is divided into three separate villages around or near the lake. We have chosen the Crystal Hotel which is located in Dorf. The village of Dorf has the enviable location of being on the shore of the lake and has the pick of shops, nightlife, and restaurants. St Moritz Bad is less than 2km away and Celerina is 3km away on the other side of Dorf. All three link by lift into the core of the ski area at Corviglia at 2,486m.

The academic and professional program has always been the centrepiece of our conferences, but an equally important part is the networking activities we organise outside the formal program. Over the years many delegates have forged professional links with other practitioners arising out of meeting for the first time at the

conferences. The informal networks established have led to a mutual referring of clients and, through being aware of other practitioners' specialties; practitioners have gained access to professional resources which previously would have been either inaccessible or unknown. Delegates have also reported that the informal interaction with other delegates has led to the cross-pollination of ideas, exchange of methodologies and an enhancement of professional camaraderie among fellow practitioners. Many retired professionals still attend CPE's conferences because of the camaraderie and networking events associated with the conferences. We encourage all delegates to treat CPE's conferences as a genuine networking event and suggest bringing plenty of business cards.

Continuing Professional Education has now run well over a 150 international conferences in the last 22 years. CPE's conferences are now entrenched as part of the medical continuing education calendar for general practitioners, specialists, surgeons and academics from all over the world. It is essential for our professional development to mix with colleagues from different jurisdictions and hear papers from international experts.

Academic sessions will be held at the Crystal Hotel.

The conference hotel is the 4-star *Crystal Hotel* located in Dorf, central St Moritz. The property offers traditional alpine style with a modern twist. Warm wood is complemented by cosy materials, while real marble graces the bathroom.
