Due to national restrictions it has become challenging getting a medical work permit for colleagues from abroad, but Dr. Dirk Richter, Prof. Christoph Heitmann, the successor of Prof. Axel Feller and myself are trusting that also in April 2019 we will have a great international faculty, who will show you their concepts of salvage procedures – in addition, cases from last year will be discussed.

You are warmly invited to send me some of your problem cases anonymously, or if you wish you can present them by yourself.

I am certain that after the successful SOS meeting in Cologne 2017 you will also enjoy the next one in Stuttgart. I look forward to welcoming you in April 2019.

Payment
