The day will provide the opportunity to meet all different professionals within the field with the aim of building a support network to further improve patient care.

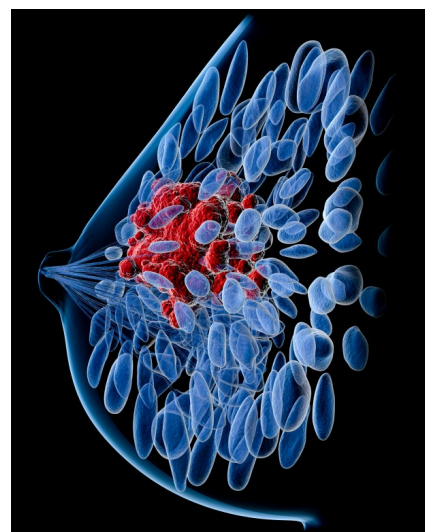
