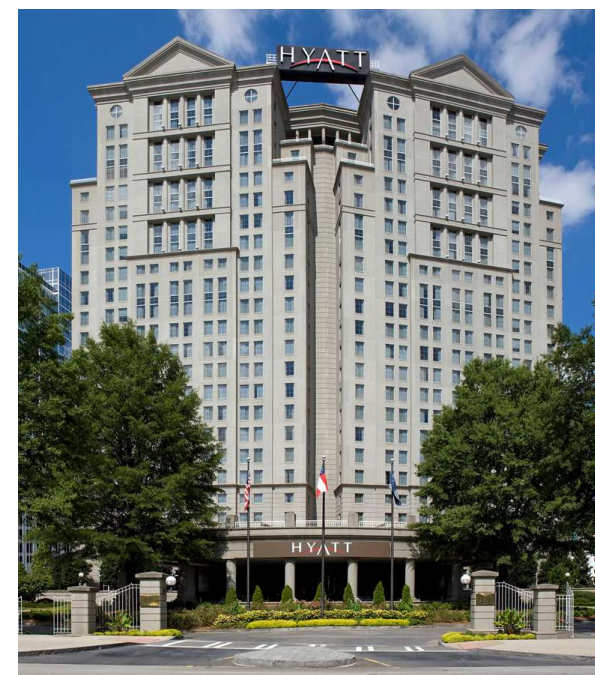

Speaker Bios



Dr. Sarat Thikkurissy

Dr. S.Thikkurissy is Professor and The Robert Creedon Endowed Chair of Dentistry at Cincinnati Children’s Hospital. Thikkurissy obtained his D.D.S. from New York University. He completed the program in Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD-1) at Wright Patterson and was active duty in the U.S. Air Force for eight years: including serving as chief of pediatric dentistry at Ramstein AFB in Germany. Thikkurissy obtained his certificate in pediatric dentistry/master’s degree from The Ohio State University. Thikkurissy is a diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. He is the current chair of the AAPD Committee on Sedation and Anesthesia, and AAPD representative on the ADA Committee on Dental Education and Licensure group on Sedation. Additionally, he has served on the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry Examination committee. In 2017 he was awarded the AAPD Pediatric Dentist of the Year award, and in 2019 was named the Aubrey Rose Foundation ‘Above and Beyond Doctor’ for his work with special needs populations. He has published in the areas of, morbidities, quality of life and pain management in children



Paul A. Bahn, III, DMD

Dr. Bahn is a graduate of the Temple University School of Dentistry (2006-magna cum laude) and Temple University Hospital-Episcopal Division (2008) with his pediatric dental certificate. During his second year in residency, he served as the chief resident. He is the former clinical program director and current program director for the Temple University Hospital-Northeastern Campus Pediatric Dental Resident Program. The program is one the largest pediatric dental residency in the United States, consisting of 20 pediatric dental residents. The program performs over 2,200 oral conscious sedations each year.

Previously he was awarded the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (AAPD) Master Clinician Scholarship and is currently appointed to the AAPD’s Speakers Bureau. He currently serves as an Oral Board Examiner for the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry (ABPD) and is board certified by the ABPD and the American Board of Laser Surgery (ABLS).

Clinically he enjoys teaching and performing various routes of conscious sedation, advanced restorative options and techniques for hypomineralized and hypoplastic molars and the utilization of a carbon dioxide laser in pediatric dentistry.

EMILY KNIPPER, M.D. will speak about a “Red Flag Conditions: Patients with Increased Risk for Sedation “

Dr. Knipper received her medical degree from the Wake Forest School of Medicine, in North Carolina, and then completed a residency in Anesthesiology at the University of Virginia and a fellowship in Pediatric Anesthesia at Seattle Children’s Hospital in Seattle, WA. As an Attending Physician at Seattle Children’s Hospital, she has been first author on several papers, participated in funded research, and participated actively in resident and fellow education. Dr. Knipper is board-certified in both the specialty of anesthesiology and the subspecialty of pediatric anesthesiology.



Dr. Knipper joined PDAA in 2021 and provides IV Sedation Services in Charlotte NC and surrounding areas.

JEFF PLAGENHOEF, MD will speak about “AAPD Policy/Guidelines for Selecting Anesthesia Providers for the Delivery of Office-Based Deep Sedation/General Anesthesia”

Dr. Plagenhoef received his medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia, and completed his anesthesiology residency, focusing on cardiac anesthesia, at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) including being selected Chief Resident. His residency pediatric training was at the Children’s Hospital of Alabama. Dr. Plagenhoef is board-certified specialty of anesthesiology.



At the national leadership level, Dr. Plagenhoef served in numerous leadership positions within the American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA). He served on ASA’s Administrative Council and Executive Committees from 2012-2018, including serving as 1st Vice President, President Elect, President and Immediate Past President. One of many patient safety initiatives he was passionate about during his national leadership was that of improving dental office anesthesia safety for children.

Dr. Plagenhoef joined PDAA in 2020 and is/has provided IV sedation services in AL, AR, MS, TN and TX.

ROBERT WATSON, MD will speak on the topic of “Natural Airway vs. Tracheal Intubation: Options for Airway Management during Anesthesia for Dental Treatment”

Dr. Watson received his medical degree from the University of Alabama School of Medicine in Birmingham, Alabama. He completed his anesthesiology residency training at the University of Alabama at Birmingham and received his pediatric anesthesiology training at the Children’s Hospital of Alabama. Upon completion of his training, Dr. Watson spent thirteen years providing anesthesia care at the University of South Alabama Children’s and Women’s Hospital as well as at USA Health University Hospital. While at the University of South Alabama, he gave numerous lectures and actively participated in the clinical education of medical students and resident physicians. Dr. Watson is board-certified in both the specialty of anesthesiology and the subspecialty of pediatric anesthesiology.



Dr. Watson joined PDAA in 2019 and provides IV sedation services to pediatric dental patients in south Alabama and the Florida Panhandle.
