2021 NCSEPS ANNUAL MEETING

Target Audience and Purpose

The purpose of this educational activity is to present important medical and surgical updates in the field of ophthalmology and to provide comprehensive reviews of various ocular disorders. The program strives to improve the breadth of knowledge of attendees in order to enhance their clinical practice and continue to improve the quality of patient care. The target audience includes active practicing and academic ophthalmologists, fellows, residents in training, medical students, and physician assistants employed by ophthalmology practices and/or academic departments.

Objectives

- » Discuss how to select an intraocular lens prior to cataract surgery
