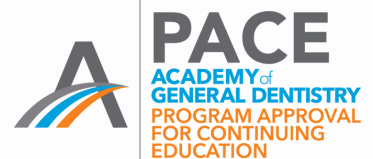

A recognized expert in dental and portrait photography, Dr. Spoor teaches advances clinical programs to practicing dentists in aesthetics and occlusion, and he continues to be sought out as a lecturer in the dental profession for his artistic abilities, creativity, and technical expertise.
