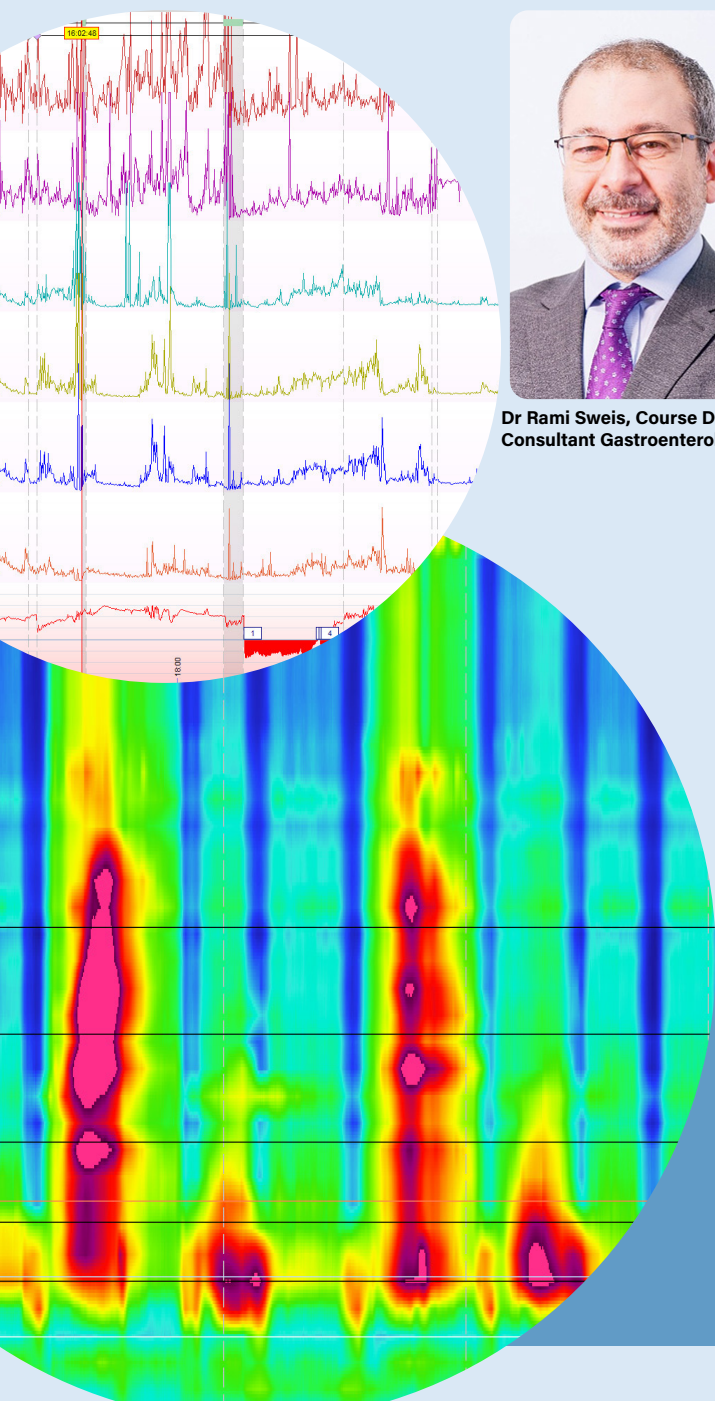


OESOPHAGEAL PHYSIOLOGY VIRTUAL SYMPOSIUM 2025
