

## ***Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Provider Course***

### **Course Description**

Providers will enhance their skills in the treatment of the adult victim of a cardiac arrest or other cardiopulmonary emergencies. ACLS emphasizes the importance of basic life support CPR to patient survival; the integration of effective basic life support with advanced cardiovascular life support interventions; and the importance of effective team interaction and communication during resuscitation.

The American Heart Association strongly promotes knowledge and proficiency in all AHA courses and has developed instructional materials for this purpose. Use of these materials in an educational course does not represent course sponsorship by the AHA. ### **Intended Audience**

Registered nurses, physicians, emergency technicians, respiratory therapists, emergency personnel in Intensive Care or Critical Care departments, emergency medical providers, and other professionals whose jobs require completion of a written test and successful skills performance.

- Precourse Self-Assessment test with a score of 80% or higher (registrants must bring a printout of the test to class; ***no admittance without the precourse self-assessment test with a passing score***).
