SAM 2018 PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN PROGRAM

The Florida Podiatric Medical Association conducts one of the finest podiatric meetings in the country each year. The Science & Management Symposium (SAM) is held in the Orlando, Florida area every January, an area that offers a wide variety of activities and attractions for attendees and their families.

We encourage you to check the SAM 2018 website often for additional information and updates to the Physician Schedule At-A-Glance up until the conference in January.

Continuing Education Contact Hours (CECH) Scanning Policy

Every attendee of the SAM 2018 Podiatric Physician Program will be assigned a scanning name badge upon check-in. This badge will need to be scanned at the **beginning and end of each session** you attend in order to determine the exact time of attendance and assign CECH accordingly. You must scan in and out of each lecture hall that you enter in order to receive CECH. Some lectures/workshops will also require that you sign in prior to attending.

Total CECH will be calculated from the scanning name badges that each physician uses to enter the lecture halls. Those contact hours will be submitted to CE Broker by FPMA once the conference is over and all hours have been verified.

A log will be posted in the registration area each day for you to review your earned hours and submit corrections, if necessary. FPMA recommends that ALL attendees check this log each day of the conference to make sure they are receiving the correct number of CECH.

In Florida, a total of **40 CECH** is necessary for Podiatric Physician relicensure. Practice Management hours are not required and are limited to 3.0 hours per biennium; Risk Management is limited to 1.0 hour per biennium; Laws & Rules is limited to 1.0 hour per biennium; and Medical Errors is limited to 2.0 hours per biennium. The remaining hours earned can be Scientific.

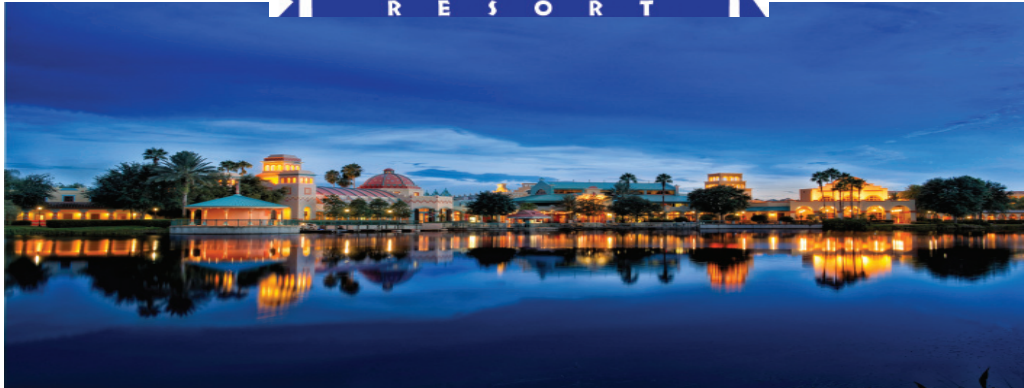
