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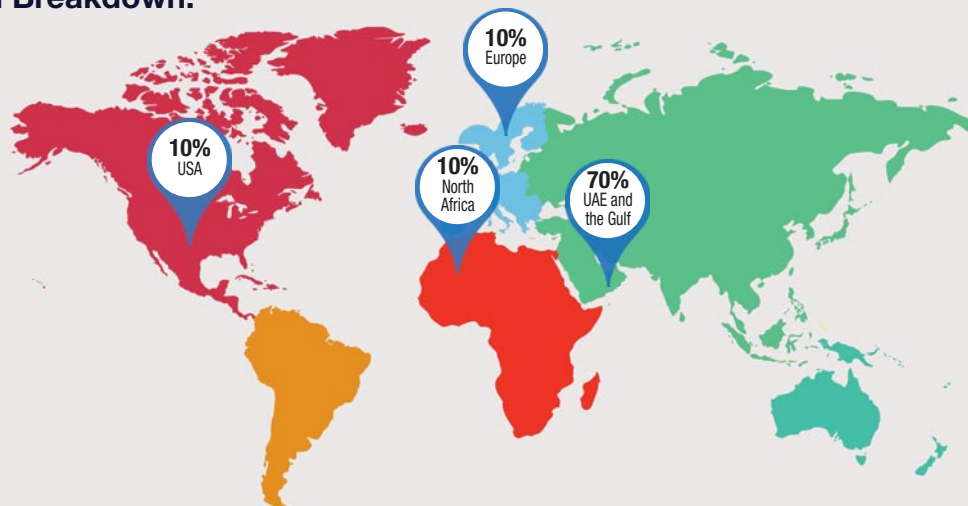

Paediatrics EEG:

The electrical activity of the brain changes during growth and development. Therefore, children develop different pathological conditions from adults that are often age specific. Hence, Pediatric EEGs must be recorded and interpreted with special attention given to the child's age and developmental level. An EEGer must possess knowledge of normal as well as abnormal features for each age. EEG monitoring evaluates seizures and neurological and behavioral disorders.

- To **understand** the role of EEG in epilepsy and other disorders diagnosis
- To **determine** if the patient's problem is physical in nature
- To **learn** how to utilize the results to plan the appropriate treatment for the patient

Workshop B: 13:00-16:00

Office Management of Epilepsy

Epilepsy in children is mostly diagnosed and treated in an ambulatory office setting. The workshop will review the best practices from the time of diagnosis through to remission and beyond.

Most children with epilepsy do not have many seizures and need not have significant restrictions on their activities. In the long run, comorbidities (especially learning and behavior problems) have a greater impact on social function than the epilepsy. Management of these problems may extend well beyond remission of the epilepsy.

Learning Objectives:

- To **review** the importance of electroencephalogram and magnetic resonance imaging at the diagnosis stage
- To **select** the best antiepileptic drugs
- To **understand** the associated comorbidities with epilepsy
