Room Rates

Room rates are \$369/night single or double occupancy for Run of House rooms, \$389 for Resort View, and \$409 for Mountain View. Current room tax is 11% (subject to change) and all rooms are subject to an additional \$25 mandatory Resort Charge. This charge is per night per room and includes the following services: toll free and local calling, in-room high speed internet access, entrance to fitness center, in-room coffee and tea, and a newspaper available upon request. Children under 16 stay free in room with parent or adult. There is a \$40 per person charge for third and fourth persons (over 18) sharing a room. Handicap accessible rooms are available. Check-in time is after 4:00 p.m. and check-out time is 11:00 a.m.
