



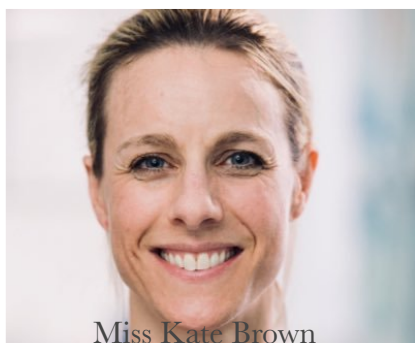
# Peripheral Nerve Course
