Roberta Ashley CRNA EdD CHSE is the only Advanced Trauma Life Support certified CRNA at LAC/USC Medical Center. She is OMS Anesthesiology Education Director and Assistant Professor of Clinical Anesthesiology at Keck School of Medicine of USC. She supervises OMS Resident Anesthesiology Education at the Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC and Harbor-UCLA Medical Center. Dr Ashley received her Doctor of Educational Psychology and Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator. She developed a cognitive task analysis guided educational protocol for instructing oral and maxillofacial surgeons how to diagnose and treat airway obstruction in their office-based operator anesthetist model. Dr Ashley is on the SCOA Board of Directors.

Nam Cho DDS MD is the Director for the Residency Training Program in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. He is actively involved in educating residents in the clinic and operating room setting. Dr Cho completed his undergraduate studies at UCLA with a BS in Microbiology. He completed Dental School, Medical School, General Surgery Internship and Residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at USC.

David Cummings DDS earned his undergraduate degree at the University of California San Diego, DDS and Residency in OMS at the USC School of Dentistry. After residency he completed a Fellowship in reconstructive jaw surgery. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and has served on the Board of Examiners.
