Dear endoscopist and endoscopy-nurse,

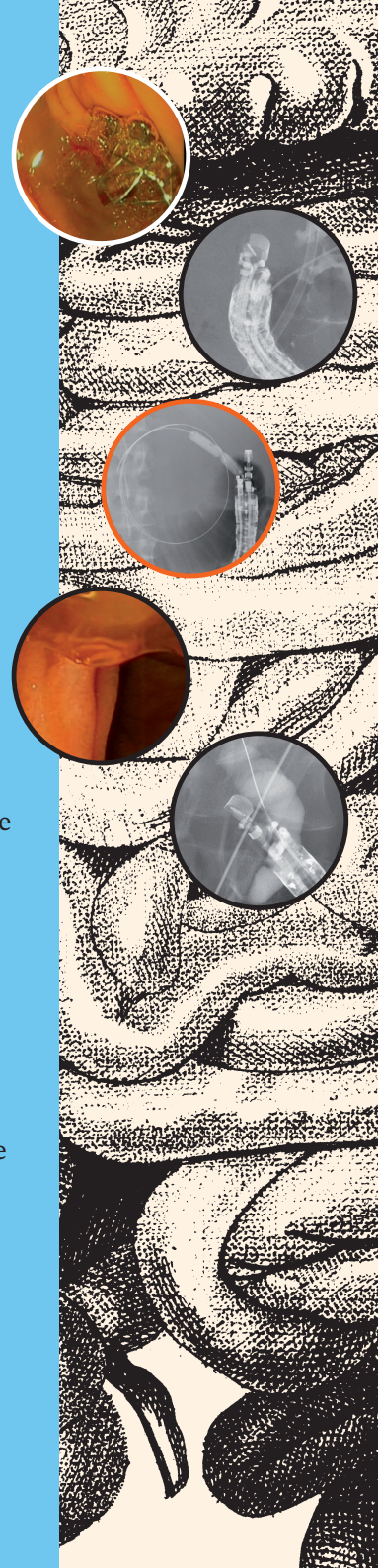
