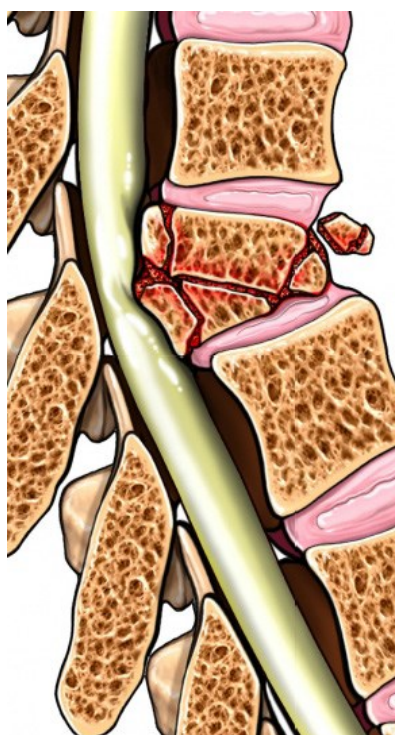
Event Aims
