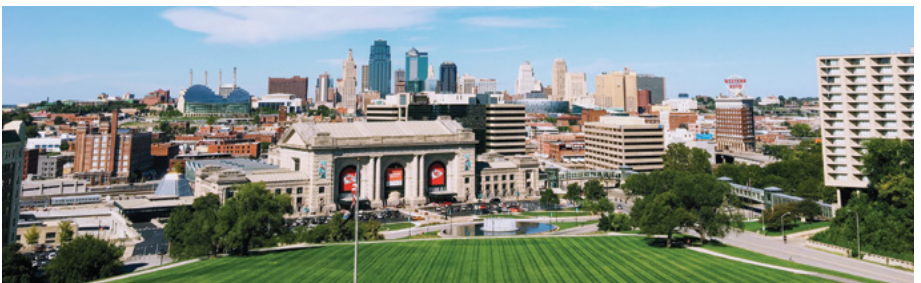
Accommodations
