It is our great pleasure to announce the **12th International Congress on Myeloproliferative Neoplasms**, scheduled for October 24-25, 2019 in New York City, and to invite you to be a part of this premier event!

The 12th International Congress on MPNs will focus on timely topics of interest to hematologists and oncologists who treat patients with these rare disorders. The Congress program format will utilize case presentations to highlight the essential features of MPN pathophysiology, diagnosis and management, as well as the roles of next generation sequencing and the MPN driver mutation and allele burden in clinical decision making. In addition to defining the role of pegylated interferon and its long-acting derivatives in MPN therapy, the role of immunotherapy in the MPNs and novel agents for MPN treatment will be reviewed.

To allow more time for participant questions, time has also been allotted for a panel discussion with Congress faculty.
