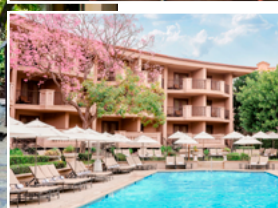
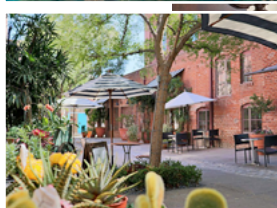
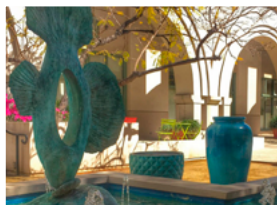
MEETING CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

Huntington and Arabella Huntington. It houses an extensive 17th to mid-20th century art collection, including the famous Gainsborough's Blue Boy, an historical library, often referred to as 'the library of libraries,' housing an original version of the Gutenberg



Bible, and approximately 130 acres of specialized botanical landscaped gardens.

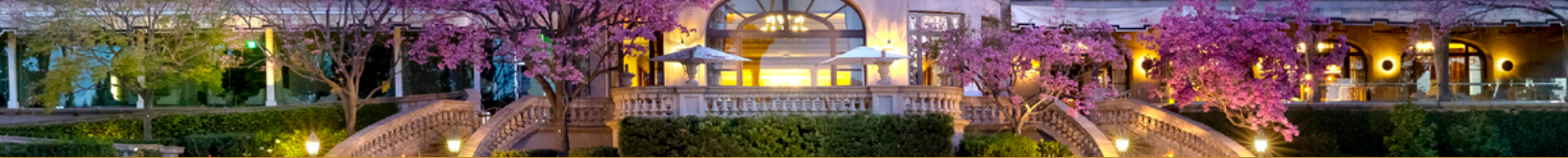
