Dr Cathy Egan

Professor Nicholas Jones

Consultant Ophthalmologist and Director of Uveitis Service

Honorary Professor of Ophthalmology, MAHSC, University of Manchester

Manchester Royal Eye Hospital, UK

Prof Nicholas Jones underwent his undergraduate training at the Universities of St Andrews and Manchester, and postgraduate training in ophthalmology at Southampton and Manchester, UK. In 1991 he created the Manchester Uveitis Clinic, now in its 26th year and one of the busiest in the world, which has treated over 4,000 patients with uveitis from the North of England, Wales and beyond.

He is the author of two textbooks: *Uveitis: An Illustrated Manual* which won the Royal Society of Medicine Book Prize in 1999, and *Uveitis: Second Edition* in 2012.

He has also written a history of the Manchester Royal Eye Hospital for its bicentenary in 2014, numerous book chapters and approaching 100 peer-reviewed papers.

The Manchester Uveitis Clinic team has a high research output; the main current interests are on the diagnosis and management of sarcoidosis and tuberculosis, on new imaging in uveitis, and on secondary glaucoma.

Prof Jones is a member of the International Uveitis Study Group and the American Uveitis Society, is a founder faculty member of the Moorfields and Euretina Uveitis Courses, and is regularly invited to lecture and teach nationally and internationally.



Professor Paul Mitchell (National Research Advisor)

MBBS, MD, PhD, FRANZCO, FRCOphth, FAFPHM

Prof Paul Mitchell is a leading retinal ophthalmologist and international speaker on macular degeneration. Prof Mitchell is Head of the Ophthalmology Department at the University of Sydney, Director of the Eye Centre at Westmead Hospital and a world expert in the epidemiology of macular degeneration.

He conducted the world renowned Blue Mountains Eye Studies which provided unique information about the incidence of the disease in an Australian population, including proving the link between smoking and macular degeneration.

Prof Mitchell is the MD Foundations National Research Advisor and provides information on relevant statistics relating to macular degeneration.



Professor Adnan Tufail

Ophthalmologist

MBBS, MD, FRCOphth

Moorfields Eye Hospital, UK

Prof Tufail is one of the leading ophthalmic surgeons in the UK. He is the clinical and research lead at Moorfields Eye Hospital in London for age-related macular degeneration. He has worked as a consultant at Moorfields since 2002, and is an Honorary Senior Lecturer at University College London Institute of Ophthalmology.

Prof Tufail's main subspecialty is medical retina disorders – with current areas of research including novel therapies for dry AMD, choroidal neovascularization, and diabetic retinopathy. Prof Tufail has published more than 80 peer-reviewed journal articles. Most notably, he was a co-principal investigator in the seminal ABC Trial examining bevacizumab for neovascular AMD. The ABC Trial became a cornerstone for anti-VEGF treatment protocols for wet-AMD therapy within the NHS.

Prof Tufail completed his fellowship in medical retina at Moorfields Eye Hospital and undertook further studies at Vanderbilt Medical Centre, Nashville, Tennessee. He spent an additional two and a half years training in uveitis at the Jules Stein Eye Hospital, Los Angeles, California, and completed a higher research degree during that time. He received his medical training from Guy's Hospital Medical School at the University of London.
