Program ...

Safe and effective treatment of acute intraoperative and postoperative pain is essential for patient satisfaction and successful practice in dentistry. This presentation addresses recent changes and therapeutic strategies for effective local anesthesia and postoperative pain management.

A review of indications of different formulations of local anesthetics including articaine will be provided, and safe dosing recommendations will be reviewed.

Additional topics include new armamentarium for local anesthesia, non-injectable agents for use with scaling and curettage, and indications for supplemental mandibular anesthesia through infiltration.

The local anesthetic reversal agent OraVerse®, and other innovative approaches for local anesthesia will be discussed. Beyond providing a prescription for 20 tablets of an opioid-containing analgesic, several strategies have now become accepted in dental practice to improve the efficacy of acute postoperative pain management.

The use of peripherally-acting analgesics and steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs preoperatively and intraoperatively, the administration of long-acting local anesthetics to delay pain onset, and the demonstrated enhanced pain-relieving properties of combinations of peripherally-acting analgesics, such as ibuprofen combined with acetaminophen, have become common in many dental practices. These alternative strate-

gies may decrease the reliance on prescription opioid pain relievers following dental surgery.

About Our Speaker ...

Dr. Paul A. Moore received his DMD and a PhD in pharmacology from the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine. His professional career has included private practice in Oakmont PA, a hospital residency in dental anesthesiology at the Presbyterian Hospital Medical Center in Pittsburgh, a postdoctoral fellowship in chronic pain management at the University of North Carolina, and faculty appointments at Harvard School of Dental Medicine, University of Massachusetts Medical Center, and Forsyth Dental Center.

Dr. Moore has served as Director of the Oral Health Science Institute, Director of Research, Director of Graduate Education, and Chair of the Department of Dental Anesthesiology for the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine. He has published extensively on dental therapeutics including analgesics, local anesthetics and sedation.

He is a member of the editorial boards of several journals including the Journal of American Dental Association. He has recently been appointed to the Council for Scientific Affairs for the ADA, and has been asked to serve on the U.S. Surgeon General's Expert Panel of Prescription Drug Abuse.
