GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

After participating in this activity, the attendee will be able to:

- List accreditation standards for ambulatory surgery centers and manage risk in ambulatory anesthesia.
- Formulate patient selection criteria to decrease morbidity and mortality rates for office-based anesthesia.
- Manage complex cardiac, pediatric, chronic pain, and obese patients in an ambulatory setting based on current evidence-based medicine.
- Describe the role of Anesthesiologist Assistant in the anesthesia care team model.
- Counsel patients on the perioperative management of pacemakers, insulin pumps, nerve stimulators, ACE inhibitors, diuretics, and anticoagulants.
- Employ low-flow anesthesia and reduce waste to make anesthesia practice more cost-efficient.
- Identify new bundled payment structure and utilize value-based modifiers to maximize reimbursement.
- Use ultrasound guidance to demonstrate the anatomy of commonly preformed upper extremity, lower extremity, truncal, and neuraxial blocks.
