STATEMENT OF NEED

The purpose of the **2nd Annual Mount Sinai Live Endoscopy Course** is to provide a state-of-the-art update on new developments in diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy in the management of a variety of gastrointestinal diseases. This course will present new and innovative techniques that they can incorporate into their clinical practice in order to optimize patient care and improve clinical outcomes. Expert faculty will review and demonstrate basic and advanced endoscopic techniques through the use of didactic lectures, video case presentations, and live endoscopy in this one-day symposium.

- **Describe** the role and impact of endoscopy in the management of pancreatic and biliary diseases.

- **Demonstrate** the role of endoscopy in the primary management of upper gastrointestinal disorders such as GERD and neuroendocrine tumors.
- **Demonstrate** the use of endoscopic therapy for closure of acute perforations.
- **Evaluate** the role and impact of advanced of endoscopic techniques in the management of small intestinal bleeding and colonic diseases such as large colon polyps, *C. difficile* infection, and malignant colon obstruction.
