Various representatives of the ASEAN countries agreed to form an ASEAN Association of Radiologists (AAR). The first President of the AAR was Dr Ganilyas from Indonesia and the Secretary was Dr H K Boey from Singapore.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Visa Requirements

All citizens require a valid passport to enter Malaysia with a validity period of six months beyond the length of their stay. Participants are strongly advised to make sure they fulfill all legal requirements to enter Malaysia. Besides a valid passport, an entry visa may also be required. Modest attire (avoid shorts, mini-skirts and bare midriffs) is advisable when visiting mosques, churches, temples, other place of worship and rural villages.
