The Discipline of Pathology, Western Sydney University runs three courses yearly for registrars sitting their exams and/or pathologists who wish to upgrade their skills.



SURGICAL PATHOLOGY COURSE

The Surgical Pathology Course runs over 2 years alternating between the following systems.

(odd years)

**Respiratory
Renal, Genitourinary including male systems
Salivary gland & Endocrine System
Bone & Soft Tissue
Skin and Neuropathology**

(even years)

**GIT
Breast
Haematology
Paediatrics and Head & Neck
Gynae Pathology**

Each day includes lectures and discussions on the various systems. There will be ample time for registrants to view slides on the day as well as the opportunity to come in early each morning or stay a little longer at night to go over any previous slides from the week.

Included in the Surgical Pathology Course is a Slide Trial Exam held on either Thursday or Friday morning each year.

SMALL BIOPSY COURSE **(MAXIMUM OF 32 REGISTRATIONS AVAILABLE)**

The Small Biopsy Course will be offered to registrars sitting their Part II Exams. This course is aimed at preparing Anatomical Pathology Registrars sitting the post Part I FRCPA Small Biopsy Exam and will be run by Professor Soon Lee,

CYTOLOGY COURSE

The Cytology Course will be run by A/Prof Lyndal Anderson, Conjoint Senior Lecturer Western Sydney University, Senior Staff Specialist in Anatomical Pathology and Head of Cytopathology at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital.

This is a 3-day course which will include a practice exam followed by discussions and answers.

Lectures will be held each day with ample time to look at a multitude of slides from various organ systems incorporating gynaecological cytology, (non-gynaecological) FNA and fluid cytology. This course will finish at 6pm on the Thursday afternoon.

Master of Medicine (Pathology)

The Masters of Medicine (Pathology) program by coursework is offered to medical graduates undertaking specialist training in Anatomical Pathology. It is a two-year program with conference weeks and online learning modules covering both surgical pathology and cytopathology, and is aimed to endow the candidates with the necessary level of diagnostic knowledge which will aid in their successful completion of specialist training in Pathology.
