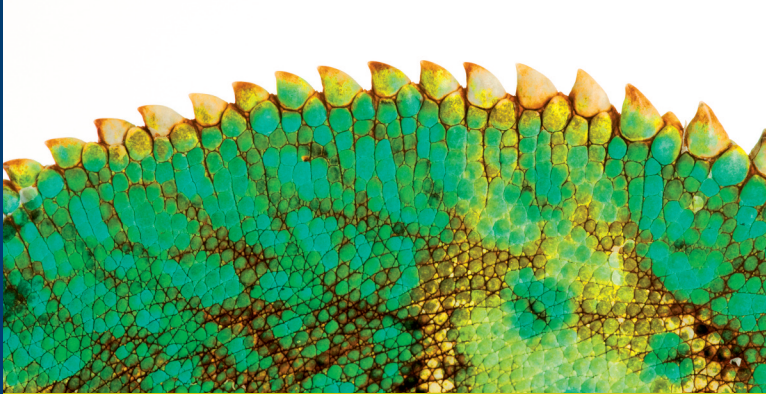

5. If you have not heard from us 14 working days after sending your completed form or 14 days before the start date of the conference, it is your responsibility to contact us to ensure your place is booked.
6. The delegate is responsible for ensuring payment has been made. Any delegates arriving at the conference without payment having been made, will be asked to provide credit card details as a guarantee of payment; refusal to do so may result in entry to the conference not being permitted.
