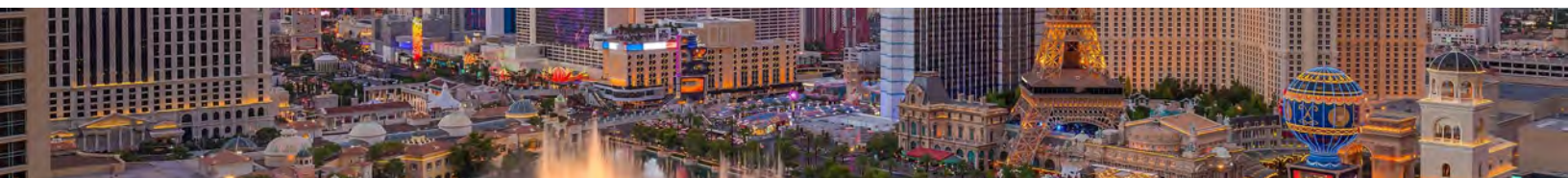

DEVELOPMENT OF SURGICAL TECHNIQUES IN MAXILLARY SINUS SURGERY

Maxillary sinus elevation has become the most predictable technique for increasing bone volume in the maxillary posterior sextants for the placement of dental implants. Following development of trans crestal sinus elevation techniques, the lateral window technique still remains as the "go to" technique for the more advanced cases of bone loss and secondary reparative procedures.

This presentation will highlight the evolution of the lateral window technique from the early rotary technique through piezoelectric surgery, the DASK technique, the simplified antrostomy design, and the low window technique.

The evolution of surgical technique follows the desire to create a more simplified protocol both for the surgeon (fewer complications, reduced treatment time) and the patient (reduced patient time, reduced postsurgical morbidity). Along the way, the major complications that occur with this procedure will be addressed both as to avoidance and treatment.

ACHIEVING SYNERGY IN SURGERY: FROM ONE-STEP RIDGE PRESERVATION WITHOUT A MEMBRANE TO ENHANCING THE IMPLANT SITE BY COMBINING NOVEL BIOMATERIALS WITH AUTOLOGOUS GROWTH FACTORS

From simple and cost-effective socket grafting to more advanced clinical concepts in bone regeneration, this course covers a spectrum of pliable preformed shapes used for bone grafting procedures for implant placement. Surgical techniques and novel biomaterials will be discussed using Synthetic Bioactive Resorbable Calcium Apatite crystals combined with bovine achilles tendon collagen to form a composite material known as the OsteoGen® Bone Grafting Plugs, Strips and Blocks. The scientific and biologic basis of growth factor utilization in bone and soft tissue applications will be reviewed using L-PRF technology combined with the OsteoGen® Plugs, Strips, and Blocks.

PIEZOTOME® ATRAUMATIC EXTRACTION & SOCKET GRAFTING

The success of a dental implant depends largely on the quality and quantity of bone at the time of placement. Bone preserving atraumatic extraction using the Piezotome® and socket preservation saves time and money by eliminating more involved grafts at a later date. This lecture will review a classification of sockets with a decision tree of techniques to graft based on the anatomy of the remaining socket. Consideration will also be taken to preserve and create an adequate zone of keratinized tissue. This course will include a hands-on portion in the order the practice techniques are discussed.

PREDICTABLE SURGICAL PROTOCOLS USING BONE GRAFT CONTENT

Traditional augmentation procedures can be challenging, invasive and time consuming, with the risk of post-operative complications. In contrast bone cements have created a true paradigm shift in all aspects of augmentation. In this course, the instructor will review 4 of the most common surgical protocols using bone graft cements, which set immediately and are accompanied by minimally invasive surgical procedures that do not require a membrane. Attendees will receive practical knowledge on how to perform socket grafting with flap reflection, socket grafting without flap reflection, lateral ridge augmentation and augmentation in the aesthetic zone. The course will include a variety of resources, such as animated videos, recorded live surgery demonstrations and clinical videos. Evidence based data histology shows how following the surgical protocols leads to clinical success and complete bone regeneration for the patient.

STABLE, FUNCTIONAL AND AESTHETIC: HOW FULL-ARCH IMMEDIATE LOADING SHOULD BE

In immediate loading, the survival rate is often based on the follow-up of the osseointegration, but without aesthetic appreciation. The main goal is to achieve osseointegration and aesthetics with long-term stability. For this success we need to obtain both bone formation and gum thickness, as any failure in one of the two factors will induce the loss of the second factor. This presentation will show my statistics about more than 3,500 cases full-arch loaded immediately (more than 26,000 implants).

- Understand biological requirements linked to early vascularization (appreciation of biologic level, growth factors, collagen environment)

BLENDING ZIRCONIA DENTAL IMPLANTS INTO THE CONTEMPORARY IMPLANT SURGICAL & RECONSTRUCTIVE PRACTICE

Zirconia dental implants are a rapidly growing discipline in the field of Dental Implantology. They possess significant benefits over titanium as a dental implant option for patients looking to replace a single tooth, or an entire dentition. In the esthetic zone a heightened soft tissue esthetic response is observed when compared to titanium, and in cases where a lack of keratinized tissue exists, both in volume and quality, they allow for a decreased incidence of esthetic complications. Additionally, virtually no plaque biofilm forms on their surface, reducing the incidence of peri-mucositis and peri-implantitis development over the life span of the implant complex.
