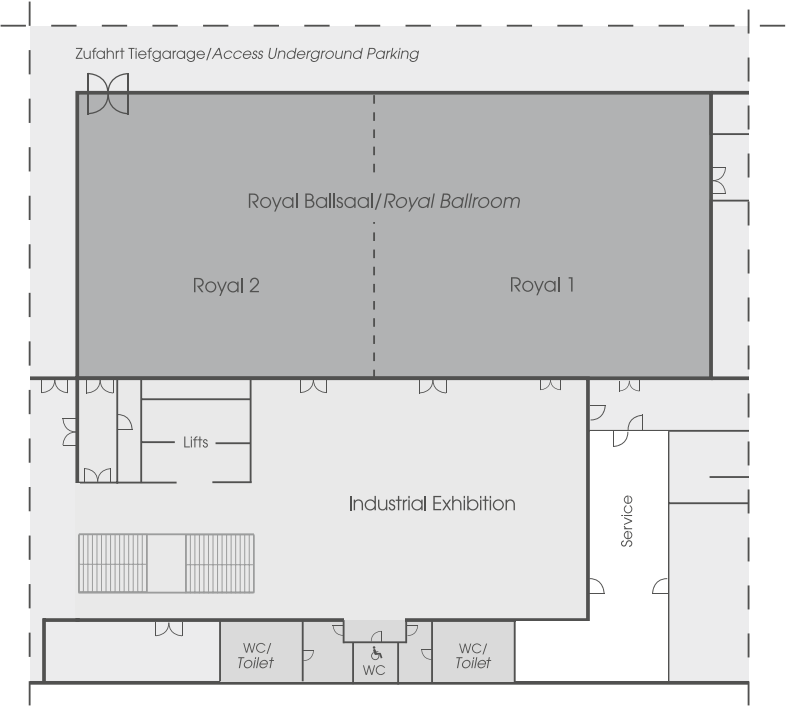
ERDGESCHOSS/GROUND FLOOR
