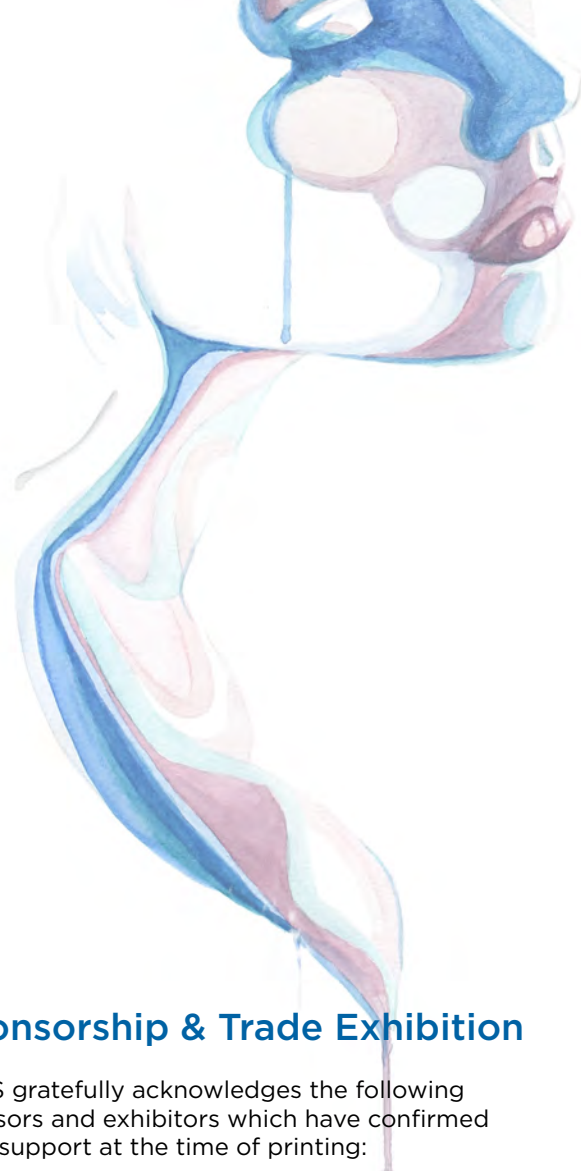
The social highlight of the program will be the Gala Dinner at the Queensland Art Gallery, which, for the first time, will also feature an exciting charitable auction.
