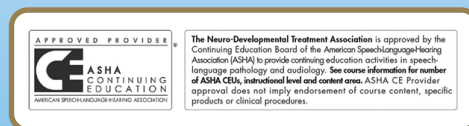

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■ LEARNING OUTCOMES

1. Observe, analyze and synthesize effective and ineffective posture and movement and its impact on a client's functional abilities/limitations
2. Demonstrate integration of course content information within practicum assignment:
 - Postural control
 - Typical/Atypical development/movement analysis in function
 - Evaluation and Treatment planning
 - Treatment
 - Analysis and facilitation of movement
 - Parent/caregiver training/home management
3. Identify components of typical movement and how it relates to the development of: sensory processing, upper extremity, and visual motor function
4. Problem solve multi-system, and single system impairments as it relates to sensory-motor processing, upper extremity function and visual motor function and chose effective NDT strategies to address identified functional limitations.

2. Participants must have at least one years' experience since registration or licensure. (Occasional exceptions can be made. Contact instructor for clarification).
