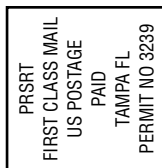

Solutions for Interdisciplinary Controversies

As orthodontists we are in the dilemma of trying to please our referring dentists but also do what is best for our patients. The two objectives may be difficult to match up. For example, is an implant the only restorative option for a missing lateral incisor in a 14 years old (NO!), or even a 45-year-old adult? We will cover long term data on implants and how craniofacial growth and maturation have a real effect on our decision making in the esthetic zone. Things that we just don't teach dentists in dental school and they certainly aren't exposed to this information when they are in practice. We plan a broad ranging discussion on this topic.

Smile design is an evolving topic in orthodontics and Dr Sarver plans to update you on some new, not yet published, concepts that you will find to be excellent additions to your practice. Great esthetic outcomes make orthodontics fun!

Dr David Sarver received his DMD from The University of Alabama School of Dentistry and his MS in Orthodontics in 1979 from the University of North Carolina. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics, a member of the Edward H. Angle Society of Orthodontists, and a Fellow in the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry.

Dr Sarver has authored or co-authored over 60 scientific articles, 16 book chapters, and his book, “Esthetics in Orthodontics and Orthognathic Surgery” was published in 1998. He is also co-author (with Drs Proffit and White) of the surgical text “Contemporary Treatment of Dentofacial Deformity”, and is co-author the 4th and 5th editions of Proffit’s classic textbook “Contemporary Orthodontics”. His 2-part article, with Dr Marc Ackerman, on smile analysis won the 2004 BF Dewel Award for the best clinical article in the AJO/DO. He has given more than 300 professional presentations in the United States, Europe, Australia and the Middle and Far East. He has given the Salzmann, Mershon, and Angle Lectures at an AAO annual session. Dr Sarver has been featured on NBC’s “The Today Show”, ABC’s “The View”, and Fox National News.

David’s wife, Valerie, worked 23 years as a Systems engineer with IBM. Their daughter Suzanne (25) is a student, daughter Leigh (28) works in graphic design, and son Dave (33) is in a Radiology residency after finishing Medical School at UAB in 2013. In 2010, Dr. Sarver was named “Citizen of the Year in Vestavia Hills.
