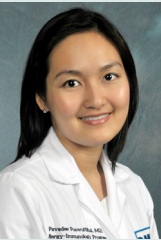
Marla N. Jahnke, MD, FAAD

- Program Objectives**
Conference attendees will be able to:
- Explain the basic disorders of impaired immunity and be able to generalize this knowledge in the evaluation of a suspected immunodeficiency.
 - Identify the various types of infectious susceptibilities that are clues to the diagnosis of primary immunodeficiency.
 - Recognize the general types of immunologic disorders that require referral to an immunologist for treatment.
 - Explain the different types of hand deformities.
 - Explain some treatment options and guidelines for referral for hand deformities.
 - Explain the pathogenesis of acne.
 - Identify the different types of acne.
 - Explain which acne treatments will work best for your patients.
 - Explain the evaluation of the child presenting with lymphadenopathy.
 - Identify red flags for lymphadenopathy that require urgent investigation.
 - Identify common causes of antenatal hydronephrosis.
 - Restate diagnostic modalities and terminology of antenatal hydronephrosis.
 - Explain when treatment is necessary and what treatment options are available for antenatal hydronephrosis.
 - Identify the current Center for Disease Control's STI treatment guidelines.
 - Restate the diagnostic tests for STIs in adolescents.
 - Explain current recommendations by the American Association of Pediatrics regarding management of patients with Down Syndrome.
 - Explain the natural history of nasal lacrimal duct obstruction.
