We are certain that ACASEA 2017 will be a memorable event once you experience the heritage, hospitality and the warmth of Indian culture.

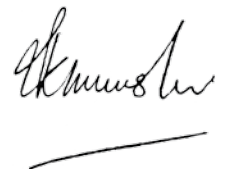
Rest assured you will go back rejuvenated both academically and spiritually. We look forward to seeing you all on November 10, 11 & 12, 2017 in Mumbai, India.
